ABSTRACT BODY. There should be no hard returns (**one paragraph**). If you are copying from another program (such as Word), then use the **paste special** (text) to minimize problems. Keep the abstract less than **250** words. Abstracts are not intended to be full papers!

Requested session (use dropdown list)*

*Use #1 (**general call for papers**) if you don't see your specific session listed and your paper will be placed in an appropriate session
